To The North Conway Country Club Members

We are writing to emphasize the critical importance of safety at the train crossings on the golf course. The railroad that runs through our property is active, and the presence of trains introduces a serious, ongoing safety risk for golfers, guests, and staff. If someone were to be injured because basic safety procedures were ignored, the Club could face significant liability exposure, in addition to the human tragedy such an incident would represent.

To help reduce this risk, the railroad has provided us with the following operating procedures for bells and whistles during movements near the course:

1. **Departure from North Conway Station**

On departure from North Conway Station, the engine bell will sound continuously, and the engineer will sound two prominent whistle blasts before the train begins to move.

2. **Approach into North Conway Station**

On approach to North Conway Station, the engine bell will sound continuously, and the engineer will sound the whistle according to railroad convention—two long blasts, one short blast, and one more long blast—until the train reaches the first (small) crossing.

3. **Switching movements near the crossings**

When switching, the engine bell will sound continuously as the train approaches the crossings, but there will be no whistle blasts. Generally, a trainman is present to protect the main crossing during switching operations, but not necessarily both crossings at all times.

If you are in the vicinity of either crossing and you hear an engine bell or a whistle: **STOP.**

Do not attempt to cross the tracks. Do not try to “beat” the train. Wait until all train movement has clearly stopped, the tracks are completely clear, and it is obviously safe to proceed.

In addition to this guidance, we expect all golfers to:

- Come to a complete stop with carts or on foot before crossing the tracks.
- Look and listen carefully in both directions for any approaching train.
- Cross only at the designated crossings; never walk or drive along the tracks.

These procedures are not suggestions; they are mandatory safety rules. By following them, you protect yourself and others, and you help protect the Club from the serious legal and financial consequences that could result from an avoidable accident on our property.

We appreciate your cooperation and ask that you share these expectations with your guests whenever you bring them to play.

## Member Policies

### General Policies

All players and their guests are required to register in the Golf Shop prior to the start of their round.

All play will start from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee unless permission is granted by the Golf Professional or Golf Shop Staff.

No more than four (4) players and two (2) carts per group will be allowed on the course at any time, unless permitted by the Golf Professional or Golf Shop staff.

Please remember this PACE OF PLAY RULE:

Your position on the golf course is behind the group in front of you, NOT in front of the group behind you. Slower groups must follow the direction of the Golf Shop Staff or Course Ambassador. This may include picking up golf balls and moving ahead until your group is correctly spaced behind the preceding group.

NCCC endorses the “Play it Forward” initiative which allows you to play from any tee box that you are most comfortable with and which will provide the most enjoyment . Please make sure that when you post your score, it reflects the tee box from which you played.

NCCC is a semi private golf club which means that, while member satisfaction is paramount, we also rely on public play in order to remain in business. We ask that our members serve as ambassadors to the general public while making them feel welcomed and at home.

CARTS will be available as daylight permits, based on the time of sunset. Please respect the Cart Return time for the safety of the staff and yourself.

If lightning is in the area, all play should cease and players should immediately head to the clubhouse. The Golf Shop staff will make a reasonable effort to inform you

(blowing air horn) of impending dangerous weather. We do not expect our employees to endanger themselves in attempting to notify you to seek shelter.

The Golf Professional, in conjunction with the Golf Course Superintendent, shall determine times when course conditions prohibit play as well as restricting the use of carts.

Please be patient with the maintenance crew. They take pride in their job and they work hard to keep the course in beautiful condition. They deserve the same courtesy that you would expect from them.

### **Practice Range**

The practice range is open seven days a week from 15 minutes before the first tee time until dusk. Practice range members may get their balls from the starter.

Please minimize your divots by hitting your ball directly behind your last mark on the ground.

Please observe all practice range signage in order to ensure your own and others' safety.

### **Handicap Posting Policies and Procedures**

It is the responsibility of each member to post all scores into the GHIN Handicap system. It is important to keep handicap information up to date. Please do your part to maintain an accurate handicap for yourself AND your playing partners. The Golf Committee has the ability to Edit and/or Reduce your handicap in order to maintain fair conditions for competition. Each event info sheet will have specifics on what type of score that tournament is categorized (i.e. "competition"). Please refer to the handicap FAQ's handout for details on posting procedures.

## Tournament Policies and Procedures

Information about upcoming events and announcements will be posted no later than two (2) weeks prior to the sign-up deadline.

Sign-up deadlines for all club tournaments have been established to aid in the smooth facilitation of these events. If for some reason you are unable to make the sign-up deadline, the Golf Shop will put you on a standby list. If a cancellation should occur, the Golf Shop will notify those on the standby list in the order in which they signed up.

The sign up sheet will be taken down on the date noted and the entry fee will be put on your account. You may pay that immediately in person or online via your member portal.

There is a \$35 charge to activate your GHIN for the season. Please see the Golf Shop to start or activate your GHIN number. An active GHIN is required to play in NCCC member tournaments.

In order to guarantee a prompt start to all shotgun tournaments, please arrive thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled event to receive your scorecard and starting hole assignment.

For tournaments, the maximum handicap will be 32 for men and 36 for women unless otherwise stated.

USGA Rules apply to all tournament play.

For Stroke Play events, all scores submitted must be on the official tournament scorecard. For Match Play events, the state of the match must be communicated to the Golf Shop immediately following the determination of a winner(s) and a scorecard is not necessary for the results to be “official”.

Any golf shop credit won during tournaments can be used towards shop merchandise only and not green fees or cart fees. PLEASE use your credit by the end of the current calendar year.

## Member Booking Policies

Tee times are at a premium and efficient tee sheet utilization is crucial for the financial success of the Club. For this reason, we ask that all members adhere to the following policies:

- Members may book tee times 14 days in advance (public can make times seven days in advance).
- One member may book for a foursome but *must* confirm and provide the names of the other players in the group.
- If, for any reason, a member cannot make their tee time, they must give the golf shop 24 hours notice so that we have an opportunity to fill the spot.
- If a member no shows for a tee time without notice, they will be sent the following letter from the Board of Directors:

Dear (NCCC Member),

*It has come to the attention of the North Conway Country Club Board of Directors that you have failed to adhere to the Club's policy of respectful and responsible tee sheet utilization on (date).*

*By not adjusting your reservation and either no-showing, double booking, or showing up with less than the number of players originally secured, you have made it more difficult for your fellow members to find available tee times and potentially created a loss of revenue for the club.*

*Please be advised that this type of behavior will not be tolerated. Any further noncompliance of this policy will result in the loss of your ability to make advanced tee times for 30 days from the infraction. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.*

## Pace of Play Guidelines

**Play ready golf** instead of honors especially when others are not ready on the course or tee

**Play your shot** before assisting others in locating their ball

**Play a provisional ball** if you believe your ball may be lost or out of bounds to prevent having to return to the previous shot or tee

**Read putts** when walking onto the green and while others are preparing to putt

**Putt out** whenever possible

**Do not be a spectator** - get your distance and be by your ball ready to play

**Pre shot routine** - make as efficient as possible or begin routine sooner

**Carts** - drop your partner off at their ball and then drive to your ball and get ready to hit. Around the green, park the cart closest to the next tee

**Pace between shots** - try to quicken your *pace between* shots and not the shot itself

*Always be aware of where the group is in front of you (NOT behind you) and do your best to keep up with them.*
